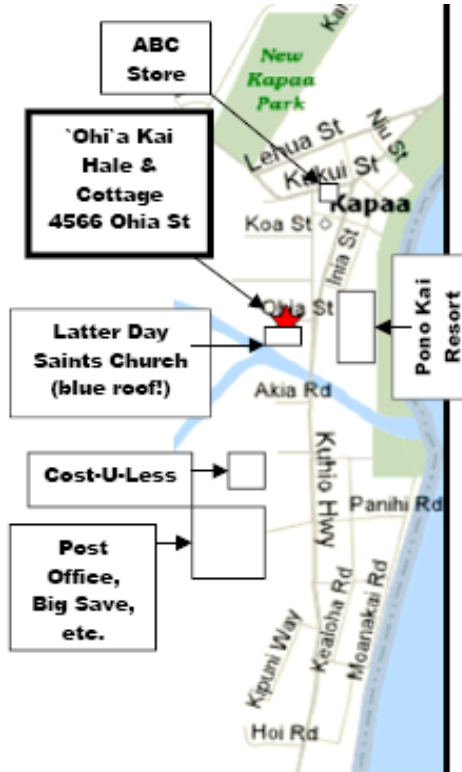




The location of *'Ohia Kai* is ideal for vacationers, business visitors, and residents seeking short-term housing. It is on a quiet lot one block from Kuhio Highway within convenient walking distance of the beach, several churches, and the shopping and dining pleasures of downtown Kapa`a. It is approximately nine miles from Lihue Airport, a 15 minute drive at non-peak times. Ha`ena State Park, at the end of the road when driving north, is about an hour's drive, as is Kekaha, the southwestern end of the road. Ha`ena is where you'll find Ke`e Beach and the trailhead to the spectacular Na Pali Coast trail. Some popular visitor destinations and their approximate driving times from *'Ohia Kai* include Limahuli National Tropical Garden (55 minutes), Kilauea Lighthouse (20 minutes), Lydgate Beach Park (10 minutes), `Anini Beach (25 minutes), Poipu Beach Park (40 minutes), Kukui Grove Mall (22 minutes), `Opaeka`a Falls (15 minutes), Wailua Falls (30 minutes), and the largest coffee plantation in the USA, Kauai Coffee (35 minutes).

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`Ohi`a Kai Cottage

Cozy *`Ohi`a Kai Cottage* is situated in the front of the property in Kapa`a, one block mauka from Pono Kai resort. Behind the cottage is a two story house.



Ohi`a Kai Cottage is a charming hideaway for the budget-conscious traveler. Inside, a small living room includes a full-sized futon couch, TV, VCR and DVD players. Inner doors lead to a small bedroom with queen bed and dresser, dining area with modest cooking facilities, bathroom with shower, and sunroom with free wireless internet capability. Amenities include refrigerator, microwave oven, coffeemaker, linens, beach mats, dishes and eating utensils. A laundry room with top-of-the-line energy efficient appliances is available on site. Lush tropical vegetation surrounds the property, including banana, mango, noni, coconut, bamboo, and panax.



`Ohi`a Kai Hale

Hale (Hä'-lay) means "house" in Hawaiian.

`Ohi`a Kai Hale refers to the roomy upstairs apartment in the two-story house situated behind the cozy *`Ohi`a Kai Cottage*. A psychology practice occupies the lower half of the house during the day.



Ohi`a Kai Hale is a comfortable, fully-furnished apartment with two bright bedrooms with king size bed in each, full bathroom, large full kitchen, ceiling fans, and a dining area adjoining large living room leading to a spacious lanai. Amenities include large-screen television with digital cable and DVR, DVD and VCR players, new appliances in kitchen, linens, dishes and other kitchenware, iron and ironing board.



The *hale* also has wireless internet access and a laundry room with energy efficient appliances is available on site. Large windows let the beautiful Kaua`i sun into each room, while lush tropical vegetation surrounding the house ensure shade and privacy.

***Kai* means "by the water" and *`Ohi`a* is a native tree that grows on all the Hawaiian islands. The lovely red blossom of this tree is known as *lehua*.**
